1	WHEREAS, the founders of the International
2	Association of Fire Fighters set out in 1918 to
3	"organize all fire fightersfoster a higher degree of
4	skill and efficiencyimprove and protect members'
5	health and welfare establish safety standards
6	cultivate friendship and fellowship provide proper

9	WHEREAS, a century ago, when our union's
10	forefathers worked seven days a week and had few
11	benefits or safety protections, the IAFF was formed
12	by fire fighters for fire fighters to become their voice
13	and the protector of the protectors; and
14	WHEREAS, over the past 100 years, this union
15	has worked at every level to fulfill the vision of our
16	founders and today, after a century of progress
17	through unity, we are the driving force behind nearly
18	every advance in the fire and emergency services;

21	DC, and Ottawa, Ontario, the IAFF today represents
22	more than 310,000 full-time professional fire fighters
23	and paramedics in more than 3,300 affiliates,

28	effective lobbying organizations in both countries
29	and our gold and black brand is sought at every level

30 of politics – national, state/provincial and local; and 31 WHEREAS, our union's strength and solidarity 32 has enabled our members and affiliates to continue to 33 thrive and grow even during the toughest of times, 34 while also ensuring that this noble profession 35 remains as safe as it can be for the greatest 36 membership in the world; therefore be it 37 RESOLVED, That the delegates assembled at the 38 54th Convention of the IAFF recognize the courage 39 and boldness of those great union leaders who came 40 before us; and be it further 41 RESOLVED. That as we celebrate this 100th 42 anniversary of the IAFF, we all commit to continuing to work, as we have in the past, to advance this great 43 44 profession and lead our union and members into 45 another century of progress through the next 100 46 years.
