Re:	Restructuring,	Refocusing	the IAFF	Foundation

1	WHEREAS, the International Association of Fire
2	Fighters Foundation (IAFF Foundation) was
3	established in 2010 with a mission to support and
4	protect the health, safety and welfare of IAFF
5	members—professional fire fighters and
6	paramedics—and their families, as well as the
7	communities they serve; and
8	WHEREAS, the Foundation was created as an
9	umbrella organization for five funds that previously
10	existed as independent entities within the IAFF (Burn
11	Fund, Disaster Relief Fund, Fallen Fire Fighter
12	Memorial Fund, McClennan Scholarship Fund and
13	John P. Redmond Fund); and
14	WHEREAS, in the experience of the past seven
15	years of Foundation operations, there became a clear
16	need to restructure and refocus the mission of our
17	Foundation to ensure that its true functions on behalf
18	of members are clearly defined and separated from
19	the functions of the IAFF, ensuring that the
20	Foundation operates as a truly independent
21	organization that is self-sustaining so it can continue
22	to effectively and positively impact members, their
23	families and the communities they serve; and
24	WHEREAS, over the past seven years of
25	operation, it has become clear that since the
26	organization, planning, execution and funding of the
27	Fallen Fire Fighter Memorial and the John P.
28	Redmond Symposium have remained, rightly so, the
29	responsibility of and in the control of the IAFF; and

30	WHEREAS, a narrowed focus for the Foundation
31	will increase its ability to attract potential donors to
32	raise funding to support targeted, critical programs;
33	therefore be it
34	RESOLVED, That the delegates at this 54th
35	Convention of the IAFF fully support the mission of
36	the restructured Foundation to focus on the work to
37	support our members who suffer burns and their
38	families through our Burn Fund, providing
39	goods/services distributed through the Disaster Relief
40	Fund, ensuring the children of our fallen have access
41	to the McClennan Scholarship Fund, and the new
42	assistance to our members who attend the IAFF
43	Center of Excellence for Behavioral Health
44	Treatment and Recovery.
