Re:	Resolution to Recognize Kevin B. O'Connor

1	WHEREAS, Brother Kevin B. O'Connor retired
2	from the International Association of Fire Fighters
3	(IAFF) on September 30, 2017, after serving
4	honorably for over 17 years as the Assistant to the
5	General President for Governmental, Political, and
6	Public Affairs; and
7	WHEREAS, Kevin has led the IAFF's political,
8	legislative and public affairs longer than anyone in
9	IAFF history; and
10	WHEREAS, Kevin was one of the first employees
11	hired by General President Harold A. Schaitberger
12	and has been a valued senior staff member aiding in
13	the union's effort to build the clout and political
14	branding of the IAFF; and
15	WHEREAS, during his tenure, the IAFF has
16	increased IAFF FIREPAC over 600% to the point
17	where it is now one of the largest federal PACs in
18	existence and developed the trademark IAFF Gold
19	and Black as one of the most highly valued political
20	endorsements and brands in federal, state and local
21	elections; and
22	WHEREAS, the IAFF has enjoyed a legislative
23	and regulatory success that no other union has
24	achieved and is respected and welcomed by the
25	leadership in both political parties; and
26	WHEREAS, Kevin's aggressive advocacy helped
27	pave the way for the passage of such milestones as
28	the authorization of the Fire Act and SAFER Act,
29	Hometown Heroes, PSOB expansions, the Zadroga

30 9/11 Act, Hatch Act Reform, FLSA expansion, and 31 countless other initiatives, appropriations and 32 regulatory advancements; and 33 WHEREAS, Kevin became an IAFF member on 34 September 28, 1985 when he joined the Baltimore 35 County Fire Department and simultaneously Local 36 1311; and 37 WHEREAS, from 1986 to 2000, Kevin served as 38 trustee, secretary-treasurer and three terms as 39 president of the Baltimore County Professional Fire 40 Fighters Association, Local 1311 leading the 41 membership through difficult economic and political 42 times while negotiating substantial improvements to 43 health and retirement benefits and the most lucrative 44 financial contract in the local's history; and 45 WHEREAS, Kevin served as an elected trustee 46 and the first non-management employee to chair the 47 then-\$2.5 billion Baltimore County Employees' 48 Retirement System; and 49 WHEREAS, Kevin served as Legislative Agent, 50 Vice President and President of the Maryland State 51 and District of Columbia Professional Fire Fighters 52 Association, spearheading the lobbying and political 53 operations of the then-7,500-member state 54 association, successfully passing legislation to 55 eliminate residency requirements, expand 56 presumptive disability coverage, carve fire fighters 57 out of cuts to workers compensation benefits, 58 increase the state line of duty death benefits and 59 education assistance to the families of fallen fire 60 fighters and restoring collective bargaining after an 61 adverse judicial ruling; and 62 WHEREAS, Kevin attended IAFF Conventions as 63 a delegate beginning in 1988 and at various times 64 served on the IAFF Federal Fire Fighters, Resolutions, Constitution and By-Laws, and chaired 65 66 the Credentials Committee; and 67 WHEREAS, four different Maryland Governors 68 appointed Kevin to various Senate confirmed 69 positions, including the roles of Commissioner of 70 both the Maryland Fire, Rescue, Education and 71 Training Commission and the Maryland Economic 72 Development Commission and as a Corporate 73 Director of the University of Maryland Medical 74 Systems; and 75 WHEREAS, Kevin is the only IAFF official ever 76 to chair the Congressional Fire Service Caucus 77 Advisory Board; and 78 WHEREAS, Kevin was the 2010 recipient of the 79 Motorola/Congressional Fire Service Institutes 80 Mason Langford Award for lifetime achievement in 81 the fire service; therefore be it 82 RESOLVED, That the officers, members and 83 affiliates of the IAFF express their gratitude to 84 former Assistant to the General President, current 85 active-retired member of the IAFF, and President 86 Emeritus of both the Baltimore County Professional 87 Fire Fighters Association and the Professional Fire 88 Fighters of Maryland, Kevin B. O'Connor, for his 89 lengthy and storied career serving this IAFF and his 90 brother and sister professional fire fighters and 91 paramedics on the local, state and international 92 levels; and be it further 93 RESOLVED, That the delegates at this 54th IAFF 94 Convention in Seattle, Washington celebrating the 95 centennial of our great union, congratulate Brother

96	O'Connor on his well-earned retirement and direct
97	that a framed memorial copy of this Resolution be
98	presented to Brother Kevin B. O'Connor.
