8	WHEREAS, Brother Osborne enlisted in the
9	United States Army National Guard in 1967 and
10	served his country honorably; and
11	WHEREAS, in 1969, Brother Osborne realized
12	his dream and was hired by the Jacksonville Fire
13	Department, assigned to Engine 4 after graduating
14	from the Training Academy; and
15	WHEREAS, Brother Osborne's career as a labor
16	leader includes service as President, Vice President,
17	Station Steward, and Business Agent of IAFF Local
18	122 dating back to 1969; and
19	WHEREAS, Brother Lawrence F. Osborne was
20	proudly endorsed by the Florida Professional
21	Firefighters, Professional Fire Fighters of Georgia,
22	South Carolina Professional Fire Fighters
23	Association, and the Professional Fire Fighters and
24	Paramedics of North Carolina for his election to the
25	IAFF 12 th District Vice President position in a
26	special election in January 2007 to fill an unexpired
27	term of office; and
