1	WHEREAS, the IAFF Disaster Relief Fund
2	provides immediate and vital cash assistance to IAFF
3	members in the United States and Canada who suffer
4	financial hardship as the result of a federally declared
5	disaster or in cases of natural or man-made disasters,
6	such as floods, hurricanes, tornadoes, earthquakes,
7	fires or civil disturbances; and
8	WHEREAS, the fund was created in 1993 as a
9	nonprofit, tax exempt, trust fund affiliated with the
10	IAFF after the IAFF and local affiliates throughout
11	Florida provided assistance to its members following
12	the aftermath of Hurricane Andrew; and
13	WHEREAS, since its inception, the fund has paid
14	out millions of dollars to our members as well as
15	provided incident command staff, communications,
16	evacuation, food, medicine (including vaccinations
17	and baseline medical evaluations), behavioral health
18	and counseling, building materials, crews for house
19	repairs, transportation, and housing support through
20	IAFF Operations and Command; and
21	WHEREAS, in 2006 delegates assembled at
22	Convention voted to support a 10-cent per capita
23	increase to fund Disaster Relief Operations; and
24	WHEREAS, in 2010 delegates assembled at
25	Convention voted to reallocate 6 cents from the
26	Disaster Relief Operations Account to the Disaster
27	Relief Fund; and
28	WHEREAS, since the 2006 Convention the IAFF
29	has supported our membership in their times of need

30	both financially and with operations before, during
31	and subsequent to the following events; Hurricane
32	Isaac 2008, Jackson, Mississippi, rain and hail storm
33	2008, Hurricane Ike 2008, Nashville, Tennessee,
34	flood 2010, Hurricane Irene 2011, Minot, North
35	Dakota, flood 2011, Superstorm Sandy (East Coast)
36	2012, Calgary floods 2013, Oklahoma City (Moore,
37	OK) tornado 2013, Fort McMurray fire 2016,
38	Louisiana flood 2016, Hurricane Irma 2017, Tubbs
39	Fire Santa Rosa 2017; Hurricane Harvey Texas and
40	Louisiana 2017; Las Vegas and Parkland shootings;

42	WHEREAS, these types of events are occurring
43	more often and without prejudice; and
44	WHEREAS, to ensure there is continued funding
45	for disaster relief operations and the disaster relief
46	funds so that the funds remain economically viable to
47	provide direct and immediate disaster assistance to
48	our members; therefore be it
49	RESOLVED, That the IAFF approve a per capita
50	increase of 10 cents with 7 cents going to the IAFF
51	Foundation for Disaster Relief Fund and 3 cents
52	going to the Disaster Relief Operations Account; and
53	be it further
54	RESOLVED, That these changes will be effective
55	September 1, 2018.
