## Resolution No. 42 COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENT: Health & Safety Re: Feasibility Study

1	WHEREAS, the North American Fire Service has
2	historically distinguished itself due in great part to
3	IAFF leadership providing its communities with
4	heroic emergency response to catastrophic
5	occurrence and by supporting humanitarian and
6	charitable effort; and
7	WHEREAS, these services and actions have in
8	general terms resulted in fire fighters achieving high
9	community prestige and esteem; and
10	WHEREAS, the cornerstone of fire fighter high
11	esteem is the selfless spirit exemplified by
12	performance "ABOVE AND BEYOND" in the face
13	of perilous risk including personal injury,
14	occupational illness, heart disease, cancer and death;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, IAFF leadership has aggressively
17	sought initiatives to address health and safety as well
18	as other issues confronting its membership; and
19	WHEREAS, modern medicine utilizes the science
20	of organ transplantation as curative treatment
21	benefitting the community at large, including
22	members of the fire service, but is restricted to organ
23	availability; therefore be it
24	RESOLVED, That the IAFF conduct a feasibility
25	study for the creation and implementation of an
26	initiative project expanding the culture of the fire
27	service to include active support, advocacy and
28	promotion of voluntary organ donation by its
29	members; and be it further

30	RESOLVED, That said study should include, but
31	not be limited to, transplant data, projections of
32	member participation (donor & recipient), identifying
33	public relations opportunities and benefits, marketing
34	strategies, and partnership opportunities across fire
35	service organizations; and be it further
36	RESOLVED, That this feasibility study should be
37	completed and a report generated for the delegates to
38	consider at the 55 <sup>th</sup> IAFF Convention.
