30 federally funded through grants; and 31 WHEREAS, the objective of these programs is to 32 educate and train the students to recognize the 33 hazards of emergency responses, the appropriate 34 offensive/defensive actions that can be taken to 35 mitigate the emergency, and to work within accepted 36 standards to minimize exposures to dangerous 37 Situations; and 38 WHEREAS, various organizations such as the 39 National Institute of Standards and Technology, the 40 National Fire Protection Association, the UL, and the 41 International Fire Instructor's Workshop study fire 42 behaviour for the purpose of developing standards, 43 education and training; therefore be it 44 RESOLVED, That the IAFF Health and Safety 45 Division work with stakeholders to develop a Fire 46 Dynamics Program; and be it further 47 RESOLVED, That the IAFF work with Federal 48 Governments to develop a grant program that funds 49 the development and ongoing implementation of a 50 Fire Dynamics Program; and be it further 51 RESOLVED, That the IAFF Health and Safety 52 Division develop a mobile unit similar to that used 53 by the Fire Ground Survival Program to educate and 54 train its members to recognize the hazards resulting 55 from the performance of buildings subject to fire 56 conditions, enhance situational awareness of 57 firefighters while performing their firefighting duties, 58 to include utilization of the latest thermal imaging 59 technology, and develop tactics and strategies 60 consistent with accepted standards and best practices 61 that minimize dangerous situations while firefighting.
